The **Paris Jodo Sai** or Paris Jodo Festival will once again be under the technical directorship of Jean-Pierre Réniez Sensei Kyoshi 7th Jodo Dan (Technical Jodo Advisor of the C.N.K.) and Gérard Blaize Sensei Renshi 7th Jodo Dan (Vice-technical Jodo Advisor of the C.N.K.), with the help of many Renshi 6th Jodo Dans and 5th Jodo Dans.

The **Paris Jodo Sai** is designed to be a gathering of all Europeans who are passionate about Jodo and the study of Jodo, and, although there are other events organised, including an International Open Jodo Tournament, it is not in any way the aim of the organisers to judge a person, a Dojo, a country or form of practise through an ephemeral competition. The interest of this event resides in the meeting of all those passionate about the discipline who need to express the best of themselves in a high stress situation (the Shiai) and to thus sublimate their daily practise, victory over others brings little, the only victory which counts is that which is over oneself ... but, above all, the means of practising Jodo in a friendly way and raising the technical level which is spiritual to each of the participants... The accent will be on the two intensive practical stages as well as on the passing of the Kyu and Dan grades, without forgetting the communication between all participants during the Sayonara Party. The following countries are usually represented at the **Paris Jodo Sai**: Algeria, Germany, Austria, Belgium, Spain, Great Britain, Hungary, Italy, Japan, Poland and of course, France.

We hope, therefore, to practise all together with the aim of furthering the development of European Jodo

Individual Tournament

Categories 1^{er} Kyu - 1^{er} Dan - 2^{ème} Dan - 3^{ème} Dan - 4^{ème} Dan - 5^{ème} Dan

The formule of competition retained for the International Tournament Open Jodo of Paris is as follows : only the JO is judged on 3 Kata.

Kata has to present will be announced on place.

We remember you that 1st Kyu is a person ready to present the 1st Dan and not a beginner.

Conditions To be registred in an organization member of E.K.F. or I.K.F. (for French, valid passport and Jodo licence of the season 2005.2006), and 18 old year minimum be the day of the competition.

Teams Tournament

Composition of the teams

Imperatively three people (Sempo or first, Chuken or medium, Taïsho or captain).

The composition of the teams is completely free, without however exceeding a maximum of 10 Dan.

Organization

By direct elimination of the teams. Taïsho holds Ken of Sempo, Sempo is judged on its demonstration. Taïsho holds Ken of Chuken, Chuken is judged on its demonstration. Chuken holds Ken of Taïsho, which is judged on its demonstration.

The team declared victorious is that which gained the most individual combat. According to the time, the third will be decided between or not.

This tournament not being a National Championship, the federal quota of licences is not essential: each Dojo, each country, or two Dojo, two or three countries, or comrades of practice... can present one or several teams.

The number of the teams will be limited to 16, in the order of the inscriptions.

A second or third team of the same origin will be however accepted only if the number of 16 is not reached (thank you to indicate the set of priorities in the inscription of your teams).

Conditions same as individual competition

According time, the demonstrations will be able to take place before the various finales.
